

Passover Matzah Kugel

½ cup margarine ¼ cup raisins

½ cup dark brown sugar 4 med eggs

(can Sub with Splenda) 3/4 cup granulated sugar

1 20 oz can unsweetened condensed milk ½ cup +2T veg oil

Pineapple slices (reserve juice) ½ cup Kaluah (optional)

8 slices matzah broken into 2x2 pieces 1 tsp cinnamon

Preheat oven to 350. Melt margarine and pour into a 9x13 glass baking dish. Spread, making sure that all sides are greased. Sprinkle the brown sugar evenly over the bottom. Arrange pineapple slices to cover the bottom. In a bowl, cover broken matzah pieces with warm water and allow to soak for 3-4 minutes. Drain, squeezing out liquid completely. In a small bowl, cover raisins with hot water and allow to plump for 3-4 minutes. Drain. In a large bowl, whisk together eggs, sugar, oil, reserved pineapple juice, Kaluah, and cinnamon. Fold matzah and raisins into the egg mixture and blend well. Pour over pineapple slices. Sprinkle topping and dot margarine on top. Bake 45 minutes and check bottom of pan. If the bottom is getting dark, move the pan to a higher rack and continue to bake for 15 more minutes. Let rest for 10 minutes before serving. Serves 15.

Topping

1 T brown sugar 1 T margarine cut into small pieces

Combine together and sprinkle over kugel. Dot with margarine.
